## LOWER CAMP

AGE 3 THROUGH ENTERING KINDERGARTEN

- Bond with peers and experienced/nurturing staff
- Thrive with a low camper to staff ratio
- Enroll in half and/or full day program

## INTERMEDIATE CAMP

ENTERING GRADES 1-3

Campers design their own schedules, build skills and develop lasting friendships leading to growing self-confidence and independence. Campers will:

- Select programs and activities based on their own interests
- Take pride in accomplishments
- Strengthen social skills
- Sing, laugh, and cheer with fellow campers during daily performances



## UPPER CAMP

ENTERING GRADES 4-6

Given a diverse selection of innovative and traditional class electives campers will discover new talents and sharpen existing ones. Campers will:

- Engage with staff and peers in weekly group games
- Strengthen skills and develop new interests
- Select free and/or instructional swim periods (optional)

## SENIOR CAMP

ENTERING GRADES 7-8

Social and intellectual enrichment is fostered through on-site activities, off-site trips, and team building events. Campers will:

- Participate in off-site field trips such as adventure tours, ropes courses, the beach, and more...
- Enhance skills with specialized activities and leadership opportunities
- Contribute to an enriching and respectful group experience led by engaging staff

## COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM

ENTERING GRADES 9-10

Leadership skills are practiced and sharpened in a diverse environment. CITs will:

- Engage with campers and dynamic staff

## MATH

ENTERING GRADES 3-6

Math camp is designed for students who want to advance their knowledge in this subject. Math camp activities focus on increasing problem solving skills and improving mathematical reasoning in a positive and supportive environment. Highlights include:

- Stimulating activities for all levels of math enthusiasts
- Professional teachers
- One-on-one support
- Half or full day option - full day campers may add art, sport and/or swimming options
